Post-doctorate position

The Laboratory of Electron Microscopy and Materials' Physical Properties offers (beginning of 2006; preferentially from 16th January) a position of a post-doctorate scientist in materials science focusing mainly on the management of scientific projects within 6th Framework Programme.

The emphasis of the work is:

- management of scientific projects within 6th FP Networks of Excellence on advanced materials,
- characterization of microstructure (especially by electron microscopy) and properties of materials.

The offer aims at a person with a degree in materials science or physics. Excellent English (preferentially as mother tongue or from a long stay in an English speaking area) is a prerequisite. Skill on management, strong will to work and the ability for easy communication is required. It is anticipated that the management tasks will involved approx. 70% of the researcher's time, leaving the remaining to participate in the scientific tasks. Expertise in analytical electron microscopy as well as knowledge of microstructure and properties of metallic materials are valuable. Female scientists are encouraged to apply.
